

## Alignment to future BASES accreditation for individual practitioners

Through completion of a BPGES endorsed master's degree, graduates will be able to map towards several key areas of BASES individual accreditation. The table below provides an outline of the alignment to BASES accreditation. However, completion of a BPGES course does not confer individual accreditation. We do however recognise some courses may integrate opportunities to work towards accreditation, whilst studying for a PG award but the final submission for individual BASES Accreditation, remains separate to BASES course endorsement. Graduates may use evidence achieved through their PG course, including professional practice hours, as evidence towards future individual Accreditation.
